This response time may be extended as it involves process like obtaining Visas, Air Tickets etc from the time of reporting of problem.	The standard response time for a defect during the Warranty Period remains 14 days however, based on the then specific issue and situation, it can be made as 14 to 21 days from the time of reporting of defect.
